

## **HISPANIC FACULTY/STAFF CAUCUS SCHOLARSHIP**

- PURPOSE** The Hispanic Faculty/Staff Caucus Scholarship was established by the Hispanic Faculty/Staff Caucus (HFSC) to provide financial support for eligible Hispanic students.
- ELIGIBILITY** Applicant must:
- Be a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at NMSU Las Cruces campus
  - Be a United States citizen or legal resident
  - Have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average
  - Have completed at least **12 credit hours** at NMSU Las Cruces campus
  - Be Hispanic
- DEADLINE** Application must be received by October 5, 2009, 4:00 pm, Chicano Programs, Garcia Annex, Room 138 for Spring semester. Applications are not accepted via e-mail.
- SELECTION** Applicant will be evaluated on the following criteria as determined by the HFSC Selection Committee:
- Academic achievement
  - Financial need
  - Content of essay
  - Interview (at Committee's discretion)
- DOCUMENTS** Please submit in one package:
- Application form
  - Unofficial transcript (**must show Fall 2009 class schedule**)
  - Financial Aid Award Notification (undergraduate) or current Federal tax return (graduate student)
  - Typewritten essay, see application for essay topic.
- NOTICES** Award recipient will be notified by mail. It is the responsibility of the recipient to notify the Chicano Programs office if:
- Recipient fails to retain a **3.0 GPA**
  - Recipient falls below full-time status
