



Outcomes Assessment Committee I Academic Achievement/Student Learning

PURPOSE

Within the overall efforts by NMSU to assess institutional effectiveness, Outcomes Assessment Committee I has the following responsibilities:

To design a program to assess the university's effectiveness in carrying out its mission in the area of academic achievement and student learning.

To focus university attention on the success of academic programs in achieving student outcome goals.

To monitor implementation of assessment processes in academic programs throughout the university, review outcomes information in light of institutional mission and goals and encourage use of assessment results in program planning and review.

Members of the committee are appointed by the executive vice president, with representation from each college and the library. The executive vice president appoints the chairperson. The committee operates under the overall responsibility of the vice president for administration.
