



Outcomes Assessment Committee II Student Academic Support/Campus Life

PURPOSE

Within the overall efforts by NMSU to assess institutional effectiveness, Outcomes Assessment Committee II has the following responsibilities:

To design a program to assess the university's effectiveness in carrying out its mission in serving the educational support needs of a student body of various ages, interests, and cultural backgrounds.

To focus university attention on the outcomes or impact of its academic support and campus life activities in achieving priority institutional goals.

To monitor implementation of the academic support/campus life program, review outcomes information in light of institutional mission and goals, and encourage use of assessment results in program planning and review.

Members of the committee are appointed by the Provost and represent the range of academic support and student services programs on campus. The Provost appoints the chairperson. The committee operates under the overall responsibility of the vice president for student services.
