Thank you for your interest in our **Bachelor of Community Health** at New Mexico State University. Entry into this major requires completion of a prescribed list of courses, available from the Pre-Community Health advisor.

The following requirements are necessary for entry into the **Pre-CHLTH** major:

1. You must be at least tentatively accepted to NMSU-Main campus and the College of Health & Social Services to be considered a **P-CHLTH** student. You may apply to NMSU via the WEB: www.nmsu.edu. (You will need to stop in the Admissions office to sign the web Application before you can register for courses at NMSU).
2. You must complete the listed prerequisite course work (See degree plan).
3. You must have a minimum cumulative **GPA** of **2.50**.
4. **Transfer students** should contact the advisors at **505-646-3526** as early as possible. Please send a transcript (if applicable) to determine which credits will transfer to NMSU and which credits will count toward the degree desired. Unofficial transcripts may be faxed to **505-646-6166** for an early and unofficial evaluation.
5. Final acceptance into the **BCHLTH- Bachelor of Community Health** major is determined by the faculty of the Health Science Department and a letter of acceptance will be sent directly from the Health Science Department Head.
