General Body Requirements

1. All members must attend 3 general body meetings per semester.

- a. Meetings will be held bi-monthly (same basic information at each meeting) 7 meetings will be held in the Fall Semester.
- b. If you are unable to attend one meeting you may substitute with attending one extra community event or social event

2. All members must attend 2 social events per semester.

- a. These are a way to break the ice between fellow classmates and other semester students-there will be 3 scheduled socials throughout the semester some require an RSVP
- b. If you are unable to attend one social event you may substitute with attending one extra community event or meeting

3. All members must volunteer at 2 community events.

- a. Every event will have a point person- when you sign up for something get their number and email- a lot of planning goes into events and the more communication the better.
- b. If you sign up to volunteer you are required to come- if an emergency comes up contact the point person for the event and inform them you will not be coming or will be late- same substitution rules apply.

4. All members who wish to be eligible for SNA scholarships must be an active member.

Throughout the year we may hold bake sales for fundraising, have a booth in the Corbett center to promote SNA, or be asked to help with College of Health and Social Services events. These are a great way to promote our organization and meet other people on campus. (We strongly recommend attendance at these events as any profits go to directly fund scholarships for SNA members – YOU!!) Attendance at these events will meet the substitution rules if you are short on other obligations.

Graduating Nursing Students:

Active membership in SNA for 2 semesters is required to receive a graduation cord or stole to be given out at the pinning ceremony and worn on your graduation day.
